Travelling from Dublin, the conference centre is situated on the right hand side of the N3, six miles north of Dunshaughlin and just before the turn off on the left for the Hill of Tara. It is also six miles south of Navan on the N3.

Travelling from Navan towards Dublin, the conference centre is on the left hand side of the N3, 9 kilometers south of Navan, just after the turn off for the Hill of Tara.


